

Creative Commons - Attribution

If the icon you're downloading is licensed under "Creative Commons - Attribution", please use the following guidelines to properly attribute it. A link to the "Creative Commons - Attribution" license summary is included below.

Attribution: please attribute the work as "by <insert name of designer>". For example, if the icon was created by The Noun Project, the proper attribution would be "by The Noun Project". Include a link going back to www.thenounproject.com, as applicable.

Location: please list the attribution where it is easily visible to the viewer/user, thereby giving due credit to the designer of the icon. Consider if you/your company are making a good-faith effort to provide the viewer with the information about the source. Where possible, list the attribution next to or around the symbol in reference. You may also list the attribution in the "credits" section, for example in an app, or at the end of a video or a presentation.

Derivative Work: If you are making a derivative work or adaptation, in addition to the above, please identify that your work is a derivative of an original work by the designer.

Database/Compilation: in addition to the above, please include the copyright license notices as they appear, or reproduce them in a way that is reasonable to the medium in which you are working to maintain license consistency and accuracy.
